SSE 90 follows and adheres to the Rule of Two Policy

Rule of Two means that the coach is never alone or out of sight with your child.

At SSE 90 INC, all coaches, staff, volunteers and team officials have taken the Respect in Sport Activity Leader Training, this Coach and Team Personnel Form should also confirm that all coaches and team personnel completed a proper Background Screening, including a Criminal Record Check (CRC) with Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) or Enhanced Police Information Check (E-PIC) within the last 3 years.

All SSE 90 INC – The coaches, staff and volunteers will not pick up or drive any child to and games or training sessions. When a player is waiting for their parents, two(2) SSE 90 INC coaches, staff or volunteers will wait for the parents to arrive.

SSE 90 INC will also ensure one of the people staying is of the same gender as the child.
